Our Key Supply Chains

In order to ensure that all persons within our firm's key supply chains comply with the firm's values and ethics, we have included in our supplier questionnaire questions on our key suppliers' policies and approaches. This questionnaire has been sent to all existing key suppliers, and is sent to all potential new key suppliers.

Training Resources

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains and our business, we make training resources available to all of our colleagues at associate level or above as well as line managers / supervisors and those involved in recruitment and procurement.

People Management

We were awarded the highest attainable accreditations as an Investor in People (IIP) and Investor in Young People (IIYP) in 2021, attaining 'Platinum' accreditation as an IIP and 'Gold' accreditation as an IIYP.
