The journey to consent

- Requirements:
 - Section 36 Consent/Development Consent Order
 - Marine Licence(s)
 - Compliance with EIA Regulations
 - Compliance with Habitats Regulations








Adaptive management

- Reducing scientific uncertainties
- Improving decision making over time
- "Learn by doing"
- Adapt based on learning



Survey, deploy and monitor

- Risk based approach to consenting
- Survey
 - Potential for reduced pre-consent survey data
 - Dependent on perceived risk which is based on:
 - Environmental sensitivity
 - Technology type
 - Scale of development
- Deploy
 - For larger scale projects consent conditional upon phased deployment
- Monitor
 - Post-consent monitoring
 - Nature and scope to be agreed post-consent

Practical issues to full deployment

- Discharge of conditions
 - Preparation and approval of plans
- Post-consent monitoring
 - Scope?
- Phasing restrictions on larger projects
- Future-proofing consent
 - Lessons from offshore wind?
